Election 2020: Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 1

Designed to Break the Downward Spiral of Education in Alabama

Introduction

On Election Day, the people of Alabama will have the chance to cast their votes for a number of federal and state officials. In addition, voters will decide whether one proposed amendment should be added to the Alabama Constitution.

Proposed constitutional amendments can be confusing. Therefore, voters need to be armed with an understanding of each amendment when it is time to confront their ballots.

That is the purpose of this Guide: to succinctly explain, in plain language, Amendment One and to enable the people of Alabama to cast their votes with confidence.

How to Prepare to Vote

We recommend that you print out a sample ballot (see Appendix) and mark your selections directly on it as you read through this Guide. That way, you can take your sample ballot with you when you go to vote—which you are absolutely allowed to do, and which we absolutely encourage you to do—saving time and safeguarding against lapses in memory. Most importantly, by thinking through ballot decisions ahead of time, you will be ready to cast your votes confidently.

Statewide Amendment No. 1

There will be one statewide constitutional amendment on the ballot this election. Voters will be asked to answer either YES or NO for whether the amendment should be added to the Alabama Constitution.

On the next page, statewide amendment one is explained.

What Proposed Statewide Amendment No. 1 Does

“Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to change the name of the State Board of Education to the Alabama Commission on Elementary and Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the members of the commission by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate; to change the name of the State Superintendent of Education to the Secretary of Elementary and Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the secretary by the commission, subject to confirmation by the Senate; and to authorize the Governor to appoint a team of local educators and other officials to advise the commission on matters relating to the functioning and duties of the State Department of Education. (Proposed by Act 2019-345)”

The main result of this amendment, if approved, would be a change in how the leadership of the state’s education system is selected.

Currently, Alabama elects eight residents to the state school board, one for each of the eight state school board districts in the state. These members must campaign for office and win both a primary and general election in their district.

Alabama is just one of seven states and Washington, DC, where residents elect all the members of their state board of education. All neighboring states have become (or always have been) states where members are appointed.

If the amendment is approved, the State Board of Education would be renamed the Alabama Commission on Elementary and Secondary Education, with members of the commission being appointed by the Governor. These members must be representative of the K-12 public enrollment’s geographic, gender, and racial makeup.

Any appointees, however, must be confirmed by the Senate and will be term limited to a maximum of two six-year terms. Currently, there are no term limits and board members have served (and still do serve) for twenty or more years.

The amendment would also change the name of the State Superintendent of Education to the Secretary of Elementary and Secondary Education. A cabinet position, this would remain a position appointed by the Commission (formerly the Board).

Although not written in the ballot language, the amendment also requires the new Commission to establish standards in lieu of common core.

Why API Supports Proposed Statewide Amendment No. 1

This plan only changes the organization of the state’s education structure, not that of your local school board. If you elect your local school board members now, you will continue to.

Furthermore, it is clear that Alabama’s education system needs to change. In 2019, Alabama’s education system scored dead last in the entire nation, behind all of our neighbors—including Mississippi, which boasts results better than Alabama all the while spending less money.

As described above, the State Board of Education, which currently is tasked with overseeing the entire state’s education system, is elected. They, in turn, appoint the State Superintendent of Education. The governor, in this scheme, is barely a part of the picture.

The problem with the governor being virtually powerless here is a big one. As the state’s head, he or she is the one seen as responsible for the goings-on of the state. In our current system, however, we offer the governor little authority over education. Our state’s primary leader can be sidelined by a board and superintendent who have no desire to work towards the policies the governor campaigned for and was elected to pursue.

Now we can't know for sure whether or not this change will lead to increased test scores and a better education for Alabama's students. Some of our problems simply cannot be solved by the hand of government. This is not, however, a blind move. A [study](#) has shown, in fact, that "states perform better when governors are empowered to appoint leaders of state education agencies."

It makes sense. In states with this type of model, governors are held accountable for the education system. (Information on how other states organize their education systems can be found [here](#).) They are required to make education a priority, or risk an angry electorate who can vote them out of office. With the governor as the only politician identifiable to many residents, regardless of the state, the voice of the people becomes more powerful, not less.

No matter where you sit on the political spectrum, the status quo of education in our state isn't working. If this change is approved by the residents of Alabama, governors—regardless of party—will have the ability to drive meaningful reform. Progress will be quicker and leaders will be held accountable and, perhaps, this will be the first step in transforming Alabama from a state that is first in football and last in education to one that excels equally in both.
