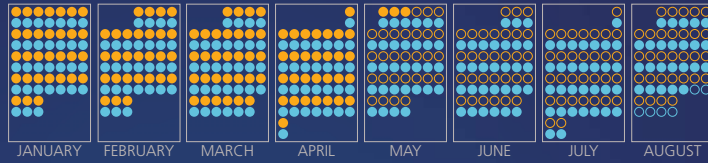

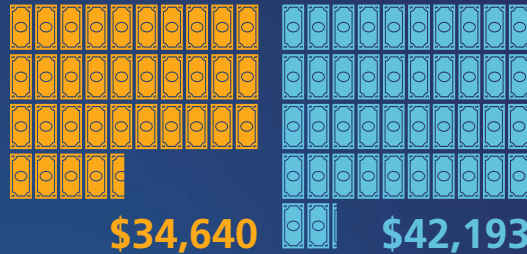

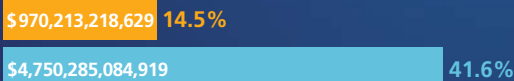

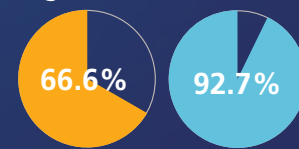

Alabama Policy Institute (API) Presidents' First Term *By the Numbers* infographics reflect data from each president's first term. Note: Because President Obama's first term was not complete at the time this infographic was released (Oct. 2012), API did not pair statistics of his incomplete term with those of President Clinton's full term. If data was only available for the first three years of President Obama's administration for a particular statistic, API compared that figure to the same information from the first three years of the Clinton administration. If daily or monthly numbers could be identified for a statistic, these data were used to calculate the statistic up to the day or month the same data were available for President Obama.
